As part of the process of finalizing your eligibility for financial aid, we must gather information about types of financial aid that come from sources other than Lewis & Clark College. Please complete this form and return it to the address below at your earliest convenience.

The term "External Resources" applies to funds awarded to you and administered by an organization other than Lewis & Clark College. External resources include:

- Scholarships awarded by your high school, religious, civic, or other organization
- Tuition benefits received from your parent's employer
- State and federally funded scholarships & grants (other than Federal Pell Grants and Oregon Opportunity Grants)

If you have applied for outside scholarships/awards, but have not learned that you have been selected as a recipient, please do not list them on this form. List only scholarships and awards you know you will receive. If you learn that you will receive an outside scholarship/award at a later date, please notify us in writing. Include the name of the scholarship/award, the name of the scholarship/award donor, and the dollar amount of the scholarship.

If you have previously notified our office of the receipt of an outside scholarship/award, please do include it on this form. This form should list all outside scholarships/awards that you know you will receive during the 2008-09 academic year.

Once we receive this form, your financial aid package will be revised to include your outside scholarships/awards according to Lewis & Clark's External Resources Policy.

Lewis & Clark College's Policy on External Resources

External resources will be applied first to any remaining unmet financial need.

If a student's demonstrated financial need has already been met with federal, state, and/or College resources, this additional funding will result in your need-based federal financial aid being reduced.

If a student's need-based federal financial aid must be reduced, the reductions occur in the following order: Federal Perkins loan, Federal Stafford loan, Federal Work-Study, and Federal Supplemental Opportunity Grant (SEOG).

Lewis & Clark Grant awards will be reduced in a financial aid package only if the total amount of external resources combined with College grant and/or scholarship assistance exceed the student's cost of attendance budget.

Although the entire resource amount may be sent to the College one payment, it is our policy to divide scholarship funds equally between the fall and spring semesters. The scholarship donor may request a different distribution of the student's funds by providing written instructions to Student Financial Services.
