Auditing

Attorneys and others interested in summer courses may audit a course if there is space available and the instructor consents. A bachelor's degree is required to audit. Auditors who wish to receive a certificate of course completion must pass the final exam. A student may also audit a course without taking the final exam. Those auditors who do not take the final exam do not receive a certificate. They are deemed "non-certificate" students and pay less tuition for the course. CLE credit may be available for attorneys who audit a course. IN no case will a transcript be issued for auditors, or credit awarded for use in any degree program.
