

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

This is a summary of the annual report of the Lewis & Clark College Welfare Plan, EIN 93-0386858, Plan No. 520, for period April 01, 2012 through March 31, 2013. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with LifeMap Assurance Company, Cascade Employee Assistance Program, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Northwest and Regence Bluecross Blueshield of Oregon to pay Medical, Vision, Life Insurance, Long-term Disability, Accidental Death and Dismemberment and Employee Assistance Program claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending March 31, 2013 were \$3,495,266.
