

Adjunct Choral Conducting Faculty

Lewis & Clark College Department of Music invites applications for the temporary position of Adjunct Choral Conducting Faculty for the 2016-2017 academic year. Responsibilities will include conducting the 36-voice select choral ensemble, Cappella Nova, in varied choral literature. Cappella Nova rehearses twice a week (Monday and Wednesday, from 4:40-6:10), and will perform several selections on a concert on October 26, a third of a concert on December 2, several selections in the Holiday Service of Sacred Song and Verse on December 3, one or two selections on the (Anti)Valentine's Concert on February 10, and will need to be prepared for Arvo Pärt's *Passio* on February 11 (performance with Cappella Romana and Third Angle New Music) and Beethoven's 9th Symphony on April 23 (performance with other LC choirs and Portland Chamber Orchestra). Other special performances may arise. Adjunct Faculty are expected to be responsible and responsive members of the music department. The successful applicant will have a proven record of choral expertise, the ability to challenge and encourage a choir, excellent vocal technique, and extensive performing and teaching experience. Master of Music or Master of Arts required.
