


How to Access Moodle & Find Your Courses

1. Log into Moodle with your Lewis & Clark username and password.



If you have not yet created an LC account, use the steps below to do so. If you have already created an account, skip to **Step 2**.

1. Go to **WebAdvisor**
2. Click on **Prospective Students**.
3. Under the title **User Account**, click on **Create Account**.
4. Create your LC Email Account:
 - At **Last Name**: Type your family name as it appears on your passport.
 - Enter information into **two** of the three following sections:
 - LC ID, SSN, Date of Birth
 - At **LC ID**: type your LC ID number. You will find this on the upper right of your acceptance letter.
 - At **SSN**: type your Social Security Number
 - At **Date of Birth**: Type your birth date (month, day, year)
 - Click **Submit**.

2. Once you are logged into Moodle, you will be taken to the Dashboard. Your Moodle Dashboard lists the latest news & announcements, as well as a Course Overview of your past, current, and future courses.



You can access the courses you are registered for by using the Course Overview section, or locating them under “My courses” in the Navigation section in the top-right of the Dashboard.



If you are unable to find a course you have been registered for, you may need to search for the course name to find it using the Search feature, available on the “Site home”.
