6 **Section 2.** Amend Article II, Section 4, part 1, subsection ii, part 2, subsection c to
7 read: Shall not be a voting member of the Senate. So that here in after the SAAC
8 representative is a non-voting member of the Senate.

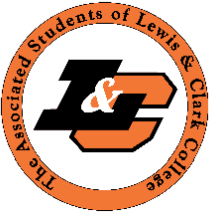
9 **Section 3.** This Bill will take affect on May 8th, 2010.

1 **Be It Enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here**
2 **assembled that:**

3 **Section 1.** Amend Article II, Section 4, Part C, sub ii, line 1 of the ASLC
4 constitution to read: "Shall serve as a non-voting member of the senate,"

5 **Section 2.** Amend Article II, Section 4, Part G, sub ii, line 1 of the ASLC
6 constitution to read: "Shall serve as a non-voting member of the senate."

7 **Section 3.** Amend Article II, Section 4, Part H, sub ii, line 1 of the ASLC
8 constitution to read: "Shall serve as a non-voting member of the senate."

9 **Section 4.** Amend Article II, Section 4, part 1, subsection i, part 2, subsection b, to
10 read: "Shall serve as a non-voting member of the senate."

11 **Section 5.** Amend Article II, Section 4, part 1, subsection ii, part 2, subsection c to
12 read: "Shall serve as a non-voting member of the senate."

13 **Section 6.** So that hereafter the Cabinet Officers of Treasurer, Student
14 Organizations Coordinator, Community Relations Coordinator, International
15 Students of Lewis and Clark Representative, and the Student Athlete Advisory
16 Committee Representative, shall no long maintain voting privileges within the
17 senate

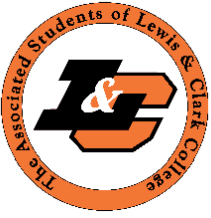

Senate Bill No. SB013

A Bill To Clarify Voting Cabinet Positions as At-Large Representatives of the
Student Body in the Senate

1 **Be It Enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here**
2 **assembled that:**

3 **Section 1.** Amend Article II (The Student Senate), Number 1 (Membership), Letter
4 c to read: “There shall be the following Senate officers elected by the student body.
5 Each elected voting officer, in addition to particular duties of his or her position,
6 shall serve as an at-large representative of the entire student body.”

7 **Section 2.** Add to Article II (The Student Senate), Number 3 (Roles and
8 Responsibilities of the Cabinet), Letter a (Responsibilities of the Cabinet) the
9 following sub-section: “ix. To apprise themselves of concerns of the student body,
10 to include (but not be limited to) attending at least two Senator class forums each
11 semester.”

12 **Section 3.** This Bill will take effect on May 8, 2010.
