The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is issuing the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) to Portland General Electric Company (PGE) in accordance with Section 113(a) of the Clean Air Act (CAA), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a).

EPA has determined that PGE is violating the New Source Performance Standards under Section 111 of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 7411 *et seq* and Operating Permit requirements under Title V of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. §§ 7661 *et seq.*, at its coal-fired power plant in Boardman, Oregon (PGE Boardman Facility).

EPA is offering PGE an opportunity to confer with us about the violations cited in the Notice. The conference will give you an opportunity to present information on the specific findings of violations, and the steps you will take to bring the PGE Boardman Facility into compliance. You may have an attorney represent you at this conference.

If PGE wishes to request an opportunity to confer on this Notice, please contact Mr. John Keenan, Air/RCRA Compliance Unit, at 206-553-1817 within 10 days of receipt of this letter.
