STATEMENT ON DEFERRED ENROLLMENT

Conditions of Deferral:

1. A non-refundable tuition deposit of \$300 is required from all students who intend to enroll at Lewis & Clark College. **The postmark deadline for the deposit and the Admitted Student Reply Form is May 1, 2012.**
2. Students offered admission off of the wait list are not allowed to defer their enrollment.
3. The deferral option is not intended to allow students to begin or continue their college career elsewhere. **A student may not attend another institution on a full-time basis during the time of deferral. Full-time status is considered to be enrollment in 12 or more credits per term.**
 - a. No more than 11 credits per semester and no more than a total of 22 semester credits will be accepted as transfer credit. The College's standard rules for transfer credit will apply. See the college catalog online for more information.
 - b. It is assumed that any academic work pursued during the time of deferral will be at a level consistent with or above the student's record with which she/he gained acceptance to Lewis & Clark College. The College reserves the right to reverse a prior admissions decision based on poor results of academic work completed during the time of deferral.
4. Prior to enrollment at Lewis & Clark, each deferred student will be required to:
 - a. Reaffirm his/her intention to enroll at Lewis & Clark College in the semester specified on the Admitted Student Reply Form;
 - b. Update his/her contact information, including mailing and email addresses, with the Office of Admissions;
 - c. Provide a statement of activities since being admitted to the College. If you will complete college coursework during your period of deferral, your statement must include official transcript(s) showing courses completed and grades received, or anticipated coursework and expected credit(s), as applicable.

PLEASE NOTE: Any student deferring enrollment to the fall semester of the next academic year, who has applied for **need-based financial aid**, will need to file the necessary forms for the new academic year sometime after January 1 and before our priority filing deadline of February 15.

Any student deferring enrollment to the next academic year remains eligible for merit-based scholarships, assuming satisfactory performance in any subsequent academic work. Neely Scholarship recipients must compete with candidates for the new academic year and are guaranteed at least a Trustee Scholarship. Music and Forensics scholarships cannot be deferred; recipients of those talent-based awards must compete with candidates for the new academic year as well.
