

We started more than 60 years ago, bringing health care services to the Vanport shipyard workers in World War II.



GOOD HEALTH AT YOUR FINGERTIPS

When armed with a computer and registered on **kp.org**, you can get access to the secure online features of My Health Manager. Connect to your health information with one click.

- E-mail your doctor's office for free, which can save you time, gas, and a copayment.
- Order prescription refills, most of which can be mailed to you at no extra charge.
- Schedule or cancel routine appointments to fit your busy and ever-changing schedule.
- Get summaries of your office visits and view most lab test results.
- Act for a family member so you can take care of your loved ones, too.

GETTING STARTED WITH KAISER PERMANENTE

The following tips will help you get started:

- Pick a medical office that's convenient to where you live or work. See the map and addresses on pages 10–11 for help making your choice. Feel free to visit one or more medical offices to see which you prefer.
- Choose a primary care provider at the medical office you've picked. We have more than 400 primary care physicians, physician assistants, and nurse practitioners throughout the region. Membership Services can help you choose. You can also find information about our primary care providers at kp.org/chooseyourdoctor.
- 3. When you need an appointment, call your medical office during weekday hours. Numbers are listed in the Medical Directory you'll receive after you join. For now, you can call Membership Services for help. If you don't have your identification card yet, take a copy of your enrollment form to your appointment.
- 4. Transfer your medical records from your previous health care provider. Stop by Membership Services in your medical office to request a release form. Then send the completed and signed form to your previous health care provider. That provider should send your records to:

5. Transfer your prescriptions. Usually we can arrange a one-time refill of a prescription written by a non-participating provider. Call the main pharmacy number in your medical office at least three days before you need the refill. Certain prescriptions require that you see a participating provider before we can refill them. Once you have a prescription written by a participating provider, you have the option of filling it online with postage-paid mail delivery.

- 6. Call an advice nurse if you have a health concern but aren't sure if you need to be seen. During weekday hours, call your medical office. At other times, call Membership Services and choose the advice option from the menu. An advice nurse will evaluate your concern and let you know if there are home treatments you can try or if you



My Health Manager—your personal health record

My Health Manager is a one-stop online resource on kp.org that makes managing your health easier and more convenient.

- E-mail your doctor's office.
- · View most lab results as soon as they become available.
- · Order prescription refills (most are mailed postage-paid).
- · Schedule, cancel, or review routine appointments.
- See a list of your recent immunizations and allergies.
- Review notes from recent office visits, including recommended follow-up steps.
- Act on behalf of a family member (for example, you could e-mail your child's doctor's office).

These time-saving features, offered at no additional cost, can save you a trip to your medical office. You'll have fewer copayments, fewer phone calls to make, and fewer mailed results to wait for.

Real-time appointments

With our real-time appointments feature, you're able to view—and pick from—available appointment times for your primary care provider. You may also be able to schedule a same-day visit.

Online scheduling allows you to make appointments with your provider in internal or family medicine. It also enables you to schedule an appointment in pediatrics for children 13 and younger.

To access real-time appointing, log onto kp.org and click on "My Health Manager."

Online estimates

With our new cost-estimating feature, you can get quotes for many common procedures and services, from routine office visits to hernia surgery.

Quotes are customized based on your health plan. They include any applicable out-of-pocket costs, like copayments, coinsurance, or deductibles. You can also compare the cost of care at Kaiser Permanente to the cost of care from other providers.

We can't guarantee your out-of-pocket costs, but quotes are typically accurate. In some cases, costs may be higher or lower due to unexpected circumstances.

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KAISER PERMANENTE HIGHLIGHTS

Kaiser Permanente delivers quality medical care and supports healthy and productive lifestyle choices that keep you thriving. In the last year, we continued to lead our region in quality of care while improving access and service.

Continuing commitment to quality

Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Northwest (KFHPNW) ranks highest in member satisfaction—J.D. Power and Associates ranked KFHPNW "Highest in Member Satisfaction among Commercial Health Plans in the Northwest."* The study evaluated the following factors: coverage and benefits; provider choice; information and communication; claims processing; statements; customer service; and approval processes.



The Northwest's best-rated health plan—KFHPNW was rated higher than any other health plan in Oregon and Washington for quality by *US News & World Report* and the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA).

Great doctors—63 of the 220 physicians on *Portland Monthly*'s annual list of top doctors in 2009 work at our medical group. That's 29 percent of the list, which was compiled with feedback from doctors and nurses across the metro area.

Improved access and service

Access efforts pay off—We showed significant improvement in member ratings for access to care and appointments, according to the 2009 Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (CAHPS). In 2009, the composite measure of "Getting Needed Care" improved 4 percentage points from 2008 while the composite "Getting Care Quickly" showed a 6 percentage point improvement.

Focus on customer service—The 2009 CAHPS Health Plan Customer Service Composite saw a 6 percentage point improvement from 2008 to 2009. Our region had the highest score of all Kaiser Permanente regions for this measure.

Sustaining growth

Construction has begun on Westside Medical Center in Hillsboro—The 280,000-square-foot floor plan includes a 126-bed hospital, the first in Washington County in four decades. The project is expected to employ more than 2,000 workers over the course of construction. And we anticipate that more than 1,100 family-wage jobs will be created to staff the facility.

Murrayhill Medical Office opened in October 2009—Located at 11200 SW Murray Scholls Place, this convenient neighborhood office will offer family medicine and pediatric care. Modeled on our West Salem Medical Office that opened last year, Murrayhill Medical Office is ideal for families with routine medical concerns. On-site services include basic lab work and first-time prescription fills.

Clackamas County gets its first cardiac center— Kaiser Permanente Northwest's Center for Heart and Vascular Care, which opened in the spring of 2009, is Oregon's newest heart center and the first of its kind in Clackamas County. The chief of cardiovascular surgery, Yong Shin, MD, performed the first surgery in April. Once the center is at capacity, our surgeons will perform an estimated 450 heart surgeries a year. Community leadership

Tops in philanthropy—As a nonprofit health plan, we are dedicated to the health of the communities we serve. In 2008, the *Portland Business Journal* awarded us the top prize in its annual Corporate Philanthropy Awards. The award recognized our contribution of more than \$6.5 million in grants and donations.

Walking the walk, running the run—More than 1,500 people ran or walked the Kaiser Permanente 5 Miler at the 2008 Portland Marathon. More than 500 of those fitness buffs were our employees and physicians.



Supporting the health care leaders of

tomorrow—100 scholarships were awarded to high school students in Northwest Oregon and Southwest Washington who dream of a career in health care. In partnership with the Oregon Health Career Center, \$200,000 worth of scholarships was given in May 2009.

Care innovations

Keep a food diary to lose weight—According to a study by Kaiser Permanente's Center for Health Research (CHR), dieters who kept daily food diaries lost twice as much as those who didn't. Good Morning America, ABC's World News Tonight, and CBS News were just three of the 435 media outlets to cover the 2008 findings of the weight loss maintenance study.

Change now to thrive later—People who thrive when they're older share five traits, according to a 2008 CHR study. They drink moderately, don't smoke, keep a positive outlook, manage stress, and do everything possible to prevent chronic illness.

Excessive weight gain during pregnancy raises risks—Women who gain more than 40 pounds during their pregnancies nearly double their chances of having a large baby, according to a 2008 CHR study. Along with posing birthing complications, large babies are more likely to become overweight or obese children and adults. The results of this study were covered by nearly 200 television stations, Internet publications, and newspapers.
