Admissions Portfolio Requirement

All applicants to the MAT with Preliminary Teaching License Secondary level content area of art are required to submit a portfolio showing examples of their art work.

The following are guidelines for the portfolio requirement.

- Your portfolio should reflect your current interests and demonstrate your drawing, painting, sculpture, and design skills. Include a variety of mediums in order to show as many skills as possible. You may include examples from a recent series or coursework may be included.
- The portfolio must include a minimum of 12-15 examples of your art work.
- The portfolio must be submitted in a digital format and can be uploaded through the online application. Actual, original art pieces will not be accepted.
