Legislators and advocates alike proposed ideas to improve access and affordability, increase transparency in pricing, and monitor quality. Some bills passed, some failed, and still others were set aside for further work in the upcoming February 2008 Special Session.

Speakers will also address the range of issues being examined between September and February, the impacts of the Healthy Kids ballot measure, and changes to expect at the agency level.
