

Adjunct Position in Photography at Lewis and Clark College

The Department of Art at Lewis and Clark College welcomes applications for an adjunct in photography position in the fall of 2013. The photography area is seeking an artist working in lens-based media who is able to teach both analog and digital black and white photography at the intermediate level. Candidates must have earned a Master in Fine Arts, preferably in photography, demonstrate a strong understanding of photo history and contemporary photographic practice, exhibit a distinct and notable photographic practice, and have taught at the college level beyond graduate teaching assistantship. Application review process will begin right away and the position will remain open until filled. Salary is contingent upon qualifications and teaching experience.

Below is a description of the course to be filled. In addition to building off of the black and white analog and digital foundation taught in Photography I, candidates must be proficient and be able to teach color photography (analog and digital), intermediate and advanced Photoshop technique including Camera RAW, and must be well versed in contemporary photographic practice.

Photography II/III Course Content: Emphasis on the relationship between exposure, film development, and finished print. Exploration of other film formats, scale, and refinement of the print to develop a consistent portfolio of finished work. Techniques and concepts address historical and contemporary issues. Introduction to color and digital photography. Students must have a 35mm or larger film camera.

Application Procedure: Submit to: dvo@lclark.edu a CV, a cover letter that speaks to the above mentioned requirements, twenty examples of personal work (a zip file of .jpps no at 1000px on the long side at 72 ppi, NO PDFs), statement of research, and three names and contact information for reference, and, if available, examples of student work, evidence of teaching excellence (syllabi, list of courses taught, teaching philosophy and any other course materials).
