### Environment: Light, Air, and Sustainability

- Provide connection to daylight and Views
- Maximize solar access to common areas
- Incorporate natural ventilation where possible
- Build with quality materials and develop palette of material and colors to enhance aesthetics/minimize institutional feel.

### Functionality

- Improve service access loading dock
- Maximize storage
- Relocate uses not reliant on exposure to student traffic
- Separate service elevator access from students
- Allocate additional space to service
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
