

Connecting to a File Server in OS X

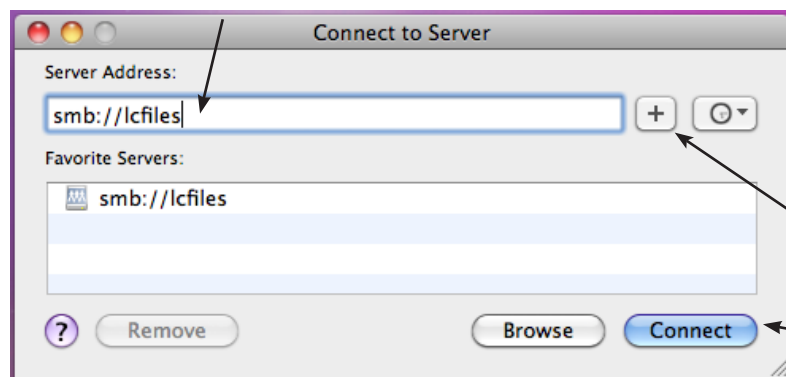
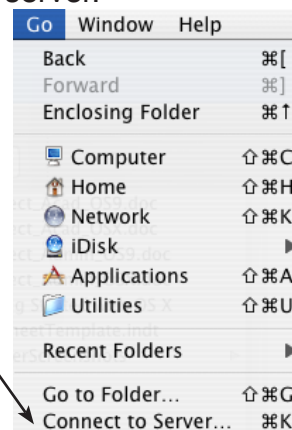

Overview

With recent upgrades to file servers, the connection and storage capacity have improved considerably. The initial connection process is a little different. To make reconnecting easier we recommend adding the server to your favorites list or creating an Alias* so that all you have to do is select your Alias or Favorite the next time you want to access the server.

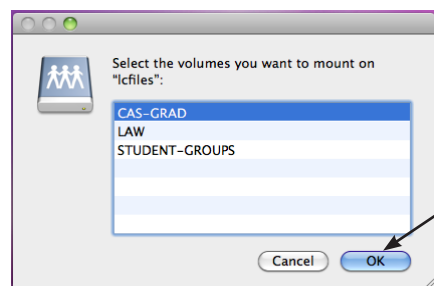
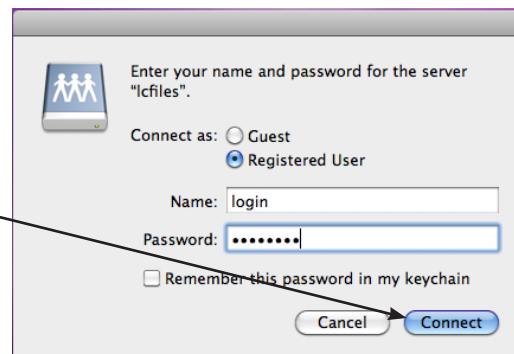
Connecting:

1. From the Finder, select **Connect to Server** from the **Go** menu.
2. Type the connection method (smb://) and server name (lcfiles) in the Server Address box.



3. Click the + to add the selected server to your Favorites.
4. Click the **Connect** button.

5. When the login screen appears: type your L&C login and password and click **Connect**.
(The login and password are the same as you use for e-mail)



6. Select the volume you want to use and click **OK**.

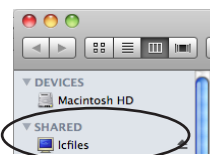
You are now connected to the server and can access it via the sidebar in any Finder window.

*To make an Alias:

1. Right (or control) click on the folder to which you wish to make an alias.
2. Select "Make Alias".
3. Drag the alias to the desktop.
