Prorated Vacation Accrual for Part-Time Exempt (Salary) Employees

How do I figure out how much vacation I accumulate per pay period?

- 1. Find the number of hours that you work per week in the first column of the chart
- 2. Cross reference the number of months you work in a year in the second column of the chart

For Example:

If an employee works 37.5 hours (7th row) a week, 9 months out of the year (second column, 7th row), they will accumulate 15 (fifth column, 7th row) vacation hours in a month.

Please Note:

Vacation only accrues in those months in which you receive compensation for at least two weeks of work.
