SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Pioneer Educators Health Trust FKA Oregon Independent Colleges Employee Benefits

This is a summary of the annual report of the Pioneer Educators Health Trust FKA Oregon Independent Colleges Employee Benefits, EIN 35-2198318, Plan No. 501, for period January 01, 2016 through December 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Regence Bluecross Blueshield Of Oregon and Willamette Dental Insurance, Inc. to pay Medical

claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2016 were \$2,231,748.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2016, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$486,974 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$427,168.

Basic Financial Statement

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$1,495,123 as of December 31, 2016, compared to \$1,793,536 as of January 01, 2016. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$298,413. This decrease includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$17,469,422, including employer contributions of \$17,443,138, and earnings from investments of \$26,284.

Plan expenses were \$17,767,835. These expenses included \$298,382 in administrative expenses, and \$17,469,453 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.
