- All [visitors](#) to campus are required to have a parking permit during the fall and spring terms, Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. [See map for permit dispenser locations](#).

### TriMet Bus Service to the Campus

The #39 bus route runs between the Campus, the Burlingame transit center, and Safeway on SW Barbur Boulevard, and the Hillsdale neighborhood. The connecting bus routes at the Burlingame Transit Center are numbers 1, 12, 64, and 94. The Connecting routes in Hillsdale are numbers 44, 45, 54, 55, 56, 61, and 64.
