Once you are done reviewing, you can click on the green arrow at the top right to advance to the next section (or to go back to the previous section).

One caveat: the arrows only appear on the pages with the Standard subsections. Main heading pages (Overview, Preface, Standard One, Standard Two, etc) do <u>not</u> have arrows; you need to click on the Accreditation (2018) link to get back to the table of contents/list of sections page.

You also will not get to those pages via the green arrows. For example, at the end of Standard Two (2.G.8), if you click the green arrow pointing right, you will get to 3.A.1, not Standard Three with the Executive Summary of Eligibility Requirements 22 and 23. (This is a known limitation with Campus Labs and they are discussing solutions).


To return to the table of contents at any time, click the "Accreditation (2018)" link in the top row of tabs:



Reviewing Supporting Documents/Artifacts


Throughout the entire report, links to supporting webpages and documents (artifacts) are embedded within the text. These will open in a new tab in your browser.
