Standards of Conduct

These Standards of Conduct shall serve as a guideline for how individuals are expected to behave when participating in Lewis & Clark activities, club sports, or other endorsed activity/event. Students enrolled in an institution of higher learning assume an obligation to conduct themselves in a manner compatible with the college's function as an educational institution. When activity, sport, or recreation club members participate in any activity or event sponsored or endorsed by Lewis & Clark College, the member indicates, by their participation in the activity, they agree to represent their student organization and Lewis & Clark College in a way that does not detract from the reputation of the institution that they are representing, and to act morally and display sportsmanship-like behavior before, during, and after any practice, competition, event, or activity. Guidelines for conduct include, by are not limited to, the examples outlined below.

Participants shall not:

- Use drugs, except for medical purposes with a prescription while traveling, competing, participating, socializing, and/or using facilities including college spaces.
- Consume alcohol (regardless of age) while traveling (from the time the organization or team leaves campus to the time it returns), practicing, competing, participating, socializing, or observing.
- Strike, attempt to strike, or otherwise physically abuse an official, participant, spectator, or coach/advisor/activity leader.
- Violate the Lewis & Clark Code of Conduct or any host rules or policies.

Violations of the Standards of Conduct may result in, but are not limited to:

- Referral to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities and/or appropriate civil authorities.
- Forfeiture of all organization funds for no less than one (1) full year.
- Revocation of student organization recognition and loss of all privileges associated with recognition.
- Removal of offending organization members/participants.

Organization Responsibilities will include:

- Educate all members/participants on the Lewis & Clark College Code of Conduct, the Standards of Conduct, and potential consequences for misconduct.
- Ensure that all members/participants adhere to the Lewis & Clark College Code of Conduct and the Standards of Conduct.
