The Roméo Dallaire Scholarship 2022-2023

Award Terms and Conditions

The Roméo Dallaire Scholarship includes the following for one full-time English language student for one academic year (September-May):

- student fee, and full-time tuition in the AES program
- the SEVIS application fee
- a round-trip airline ticket to Portland, Oregon, from the home country
- room and meals (the 14 meals/week flex plan)
- a one-time settling allowance of \$250 and a monthly living allowance of \$200*
- health insurance premium and deductible
- measles vaccination, tuberculosis test
- textbooks
- up to 500 printed pages per semester in computer lab
- full use of all Lewis & Clark campus facilities (including computer labs, research library, athletic facilities, student center, email account)
- assistance with US Federal and State tax reporting

*Students are eligible to work on campus a recommended maximum 10 hours per week while school is in session. Jobs available will be limited to evening and weekend positions; generally, these jobs are in service areas such as the kitchen or maintenance and grounds.

Award Restrictions

Please note that the Scholarship is for one person; housing is available for one person only. The Dallaire Scholarship **does not** pay for:

- flight insurance (not necessary for flights to the US)
- any costs related to classes or coursework outside the Academic English Studies program
- salary reimbursement
- TOEFL or other test fees
- application fees for undergraduate or graduate programs for other institutions
- medical care not covered by the furnished health insurance
- tuberculosis test
- a stipend for a spouse or dependent

Applicant Responsibilities

The scholarship recipient must remain in good standing with Lewis & Clark College and Academic English Studies. If the recipient is suspended or put on probation, he or she will no longer be eligible for scholarship support.

The scholarship recipient agrees to return to his or her home country at the completion of the program and agrees to serve on the Dallaire Scholarship Finalist Interview Committee.
