A Bill To Redefine Executive Legislative Authority

1 **Section 1.** Insert into Article II, Part 1, Section h of the ASLC Constitution: The
2 Senate shall present all legislation to the President for his or her approval. If the
3 President does not approve the legislation, the Senate may choose to override his
4 or her decision by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote.

5

6 **Section 2.** This amendment will come into effect October 1st, 2009.

- 5 **Section 4.** To take effect October 2, 2009.

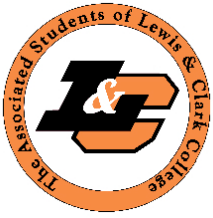

4 Community Relations Coordinator is no longer required to attend Campus
5 Activities Committee meetings.
- 6 **Section 2.** Remove Article III, Section 7, Part E, Sub I, line 2 so that the Secretary
7 is no longer required to attend Community Relations Committee meetings.
- 8 **Section 3.** Remove Article III, Section 7, Part G, Sub I, line 2 so that the
9 Community Relations Coordinator is no longer required to attend Global
10 Engagement Board meetings.
- 11 **Section 4.** This bill will come into effect immediately

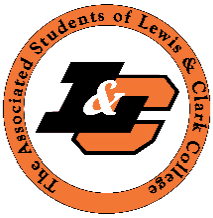
- 1 **Be It Enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here**

- 4 “Requires two-thirds (2/3) majority of voting Senators and Representatives present
- 5 to enter into effect.”
- 6 **Section 4.** This bill will come into effect immediately.

3 **Section 1.** Amend Article II, Section 1, Part b. of the ASLC Constitution,
4 following the words “student body”, to read:

- 5 i. President <non-voting>
- 6 ii. Vice President
- 7 iii. Treasurer
- 8 iv. Student Organizations Coordinator
- 9 v. Community Relations Coordinator
- 10 vi. Student Academic Affairs Board Chair
- 11 vii. Chief Justice

12 **Section 2.** Amend Article II, Section 1, Part c. of the ASLC Constitution to read:
13 “The aforementioned elected officers, with the exception of the Student Academic
14 Affairs Board Chair and Chief Justice, compose the Cabinet.”

15 **Section 3.** Amend Article II, Section 1, Part d. of the ASLC Constitution,
16 following point v., to read:

- 17 viii. Activities Committee Chair

18 **Section 4.** Amend Article II, Section 2, Part b, subsection I, of the ASLC
19 Constitution to read: “Each Senator must serve on at least one standing committee,

22 **Section 5.** Remove Article II, Section 4, Part a., sub ii., line 3 of the ASLC
23 Constitution so that President no longer presides over the Senate in any manner.

24 **Section 6.** Amend Article II, Section 4, Part b., sub ii, of the ASLC Constitution to
25 read:

- 26 1. Shall preside over the Senate.
- 27 2. Shall not vote in Senate except in the event of a tie.
- 28 3. To assist in the planning and arrangements of the leadership training
29 programs offered by the College prior to the beginning of each semester.
- 30 4. Plan and arrange a Senate leadership retreat prior to the start of each
31 semester.
- 32 5. Assign Senators to all Senate Standing committee positions, with
33 consideration of specific Senator’s skills, preferences, experience, and the
34 needs of the Senate.
- 35 6. To assume the Presidency if the President is unable to perform his or her
36 duties.

37 **Section 7.** Remove Article II, Section 4, Part d., and replace it with the following:

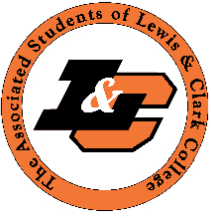

- 40 1. The Secretary of the Senate shall be selected from the Student
41 Body, as a paid position, by the outgoing and incoming Cabinet
42 before the end of the Spring Semester.
- 43 2. The Secretary of the Senate is required to make a year long
44 commitment.
- 45 ii. Responsibilities
- 46 1. Shall serve under the Vice President but be a resource for the
47 entire Cabinet and Senate.
- 48 2. Shall be responsible for recording, tracking, and enforcing the
49 attendance policy of the Senate.
- 50 3. Shall distribute all written legislation and items of official
51 business that been submitted for the Senate's agenda, in
52 accordance to the relevant procedures outlined in the Bylaws.
- 53 4. Shall record and distribute the minutes of each meeting of the
54 Senate, in accordance to the relevant procedures outlined in the
55 Bylaws.
- 56 5. Shall draft, certify, and deliver, with the President, any
57 resolution from the Senate to the appropriate administrative
58 body of the College upon adoption by the Senate.

59 **Section 8.** Remove Article II, Section 4, Part f., from the ASLC Constitution so
60 that the Global Engagement Board Chair is removed from ASLC.

61 **Section 9** Amend Article I, Section 4, Part i, to read:

62 i. Qualifications

63 1. The Campus Activities Board Chair shall be an enrolled full time Lewis
64 & Clark College student in good disciplinary and academic standing
65 with the College, subject to review by the Director of Student
66 Activities.

67 2. The Campus Activities Board Chair will be chosen from within the
68 Campus Activities Board by members of the Campus Activities Board
69 in the Spring following the Spring Election.

70 ii. Responsibilities

71 1. The Campus Activities Board Chair is directly accountable to the
72 Director of Student Activities.

73 2. Shall Chair the Student Activities Board

74 3. Shall assist in the selection of three to five (3-5) student programmers.
75 These programmers will also be directly accountable to the Director of
76 Student Activities.

77 4. Shall appoint members of the Campus Activities Board, subject to the
78 approval of the Senate.

80 **Section 10.** Amend Article III, Section 7, Part c., sub i, of the ASLC Constitution
81 to read as follows:

- 82 1. Student Activities Board Chair (serves as chair)
- 83 2. Director of Student Activities (ex-officio member)
- 84 3. 3-5 Activities Coordinators, as selected by the Director of Student Activities
85 and the Student Activities Board Chair.
- 86 4. At least five (5) appointed students-at-large, as appointed by the Student
87 Activities Board Chair.

88 **Section 11.** Remove Article III, Section 7, Part d., from the ASLC Constitution so
89 that the Constitutional Affairs Committee is disbanded.

90 **Section 12.** Amend Article III, Section 7, Part e., sub i, from the ASLC
91 Constitution, following line 45, to say:

- 92 1. *Optional Administrative Assistant* whose sole purpose would be to
93 oversee the global engagement portion of the Community Relations
94 Committee.

95 **Section 13.** Amend Article III, Section 7, Part e., sub ii, from the ASLC
96 Constitution, following line 20, to say:

- 97 8. Shall be responsible for representing the cause of global engagement
98 and for advising other Senate committees.

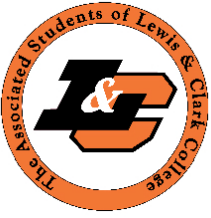

3 **Section 1.** Amend Article II, Section 1, part a, to read: The Student Senate
4 (hereinafter the Senate) shall be comprised of four (4) elected representatives from
5 each class (hereinafter Senators).

6 **Section 2.** Amend Article II, Section 2, Part b, subsection I, of the ASLC
7 Constitution to read: “Each Senator must serve on at least one (1) standing
8 committee, with four (4) senators serving on each of the three boards, while the
9 remaining four (4) senators remain at large.”

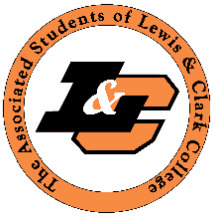
10 **Section 3.** This Bill will take effect on May 8th, 2010.

1 **Be It Enacted by the Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark here**
2 **assembled that:**

3 **Section 1.** Below Article II, Section 4, sub section I, subsection v. add the
4 following:

5 vi. Collins View Neighborhood Association (CVNA) Liaison

6 1. Qualifications

7 a. The CVNA liaison shall be an enrolled full-time Lewis & Clark College
8 student in good disciplinary and academic standing with the College.

9 b. The liaison must be able to attend all CVNA meetings for the entire
10 academic year.

11 c. The CVNA liaison shall be appointed by the President subject to 2/3
12 majority approval by the Senate.

13 d. The CVNA liaison may be a member of the Senate provided they meet
14 the above requirements.

15 2. Responsibilities

16 a. Shall serve as a liaison between the CVNA and the Student Body.

17 b. Shall attend the Senate meeting prior to and following each CVNA
18 meeting.

19 c. Shall hold a student forum prior to each CVNA meeting in order to
20 gather student input on community issues.
